



KCCC Fall Series

SAND VOLLEYBALL



Dates/Time: Saturday, September 19, 2026.

Location: Volleyball Beach, 13105 Holmes Rd, Kansas City, MO 64145

- Teams will consist of a maximum 6 players (maximum of 3 men) on the court at one time. Substitutions are allowed rotating in at middle back and completing a rotation. In case of an injury, a player may substitute for the injured player at any position on the court, but the injured player cannot return to the game.
- A minimum of 4 players (maximum of 2 men) is needed to start. Teams may play with 5 with a maximum of 3 men on the court at a time. 3 Men and 2 Women is only combination allowed with more male than female players.
- Check-in with KCCC staff to sign waiver (All players must sign waiver) and court assignment.
- Game time is forfeit time. Players must be at court at game time.
- Matches will be self-officiated. Participants are expected to know the rules of the sport.
- The tournament will begin with a round robin pool play with teams advancing to a single elimination tournament. The top 2 teams from each pool will advance to the bracket. 2 wild card teams will also advance. Of the remaining teams that did not advance to bracket, the two teams with best point differential from their pool play games will move on to bracket play.
- Teams will play one set against each team in their pool. Round Robin play will be to 25 points, rally scoring, with a cap of 30 points. Sets must be won by two points unless the set reaches its cap.
- Tiebreakers in round robin play will be determined first by head-to-head results, then point spread in head-to-head matchup. If 3 or more teams are tied, total point spread involving tied teams will determine placements.
- Bracket play games will be best 2 out of 3 sets with the first 2 sets being played to 25 (30 point cap) and set 3 played to 15 (20 point cap).
- Game Play Rules
 - The Court
 - Boundary lines consist of two end lines and two sidelines marking the playing court.
 - A ball is "in" if when landing on the ground it contacts any part of boundary lines.
 - A ball is "out" if it contacts anything outside boundary lines.
 - Serve
 - Server must serve from anywhere behind the end line and between sidelines.
 - Ball can be served over or underhand. When a player serves 3 successful and consecutive serves, they must switch to underhand for one serve. They can switch back to overhand for 3 more consecutive serves.

- Serve Reception
 - No blocking or attacking a serve.
- Rotation
 - Rotate into middle back position only. (male for male/female for female).
 - Substitutes must complete a rotation. Players arriving late can rotate in when their team is serving.
- Game
 - Maximum of 3 hits to return ball to opponent. If more than one hit used to return, a woman must hit the ball. Blocks do not count as hits.
 - Back row players may not block or attack at the net.
 - Players may touch the ball with any part of the body. Ball must be contacted cleanly and not held or thrown.
 - Players cannot touch the net with any part of the body while ball is in play unless the net is pushed into you.
 - Captains are responsible for reporting scores.

This information is subject to and rule interpretation changes which may occur between now and the Fall Series Tournament.
